The ISDUE was founded in 1951 and is a worldwide network of national organisations and individual members that share a social-democratic/socialist party education philosophy.

The main goal of a social democratic and socialist education policy is the desire to see the fundamentals of freedom, equality, justice and solidarity delivered in an inclusive education system. Therefore, the focus of the organisation and its members is to seek improvement in the education of present and future generations. Education is a human right, not a privilege.

The ISDUE network commissions itself through debates, seminars and conferences to inspire discussions and professional debates on the latest developments in education. Due to the numerous member-countries, a broad insight in international developments and achievements in education can be provided.
